Wedding Flowers Information





We hope your wedding plans are going ahead smoothly. Here is some information to help you organise any flowers you might wish to have.



There will be two arrangements already in the church, one in the porch and one on a pedestal by the high altar. These will need to be left in the church after the wedding.

You can either provide your own pedestal if required, or use spare

ones from the church flower cupboard (details on request. NB take care with step down).

As the members of the Flower Guild like to use flowers from their gardens whenever possible, we are unfortunately unable to say in advance what the colours will be.

In the run up to Christmas and Easter (Advent and Lent), there won't be any flowers in church but dispensation is given so that you can have wedding flowers. These need to be removed immediately afterwards.

If you plan to have other flowers, you will need to use your own florist (friends or family are often happy to help!) They can usually have access to the church between 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 pm on Thursdays or on Fridays between 11.30 and 12.30, or after 1.45. Any changes will be notified a couple of weeks before your wedding.



The florist will need to know that they cannot use any nails/screws etc to secure arrangements either inside or outside the church, nor any candles. Pew end arrangements need to be tied on.

You can obviously take away your own flowers after the service if you wish to.
